

## Watchic Lake Association Board of Directors' Meeting Summary April 24 2024 via Zoom

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm by President Paul McNulty. A quorum was established with 10 directors present. Minutes of the March 27, 2024 meeting were approved by consent.

Agnes reviewed the **treasures report**, noting minor expenses and some dues income. Agnes requested that the board provide FY 25 budget requests by May 10.

David has secured six DEP "clean, drain and dry" boat Inspection signs, which were provided at no charge. David has begun to distribute signs to interested property owners. Goal to have them all up before boats start going in.

**Second DEP Section 319 grant application work continues.** Heather Hunt of CCSW will assist and writing the proposal and has visited residential candidate sites. The application is due May 17.

Stephanie will provide a **Cyanobacteria summary** and David a **water quality summary** for use on the website and newsletter.

Response from the property owner interested in dredging was that they agreed with the WLA strong **recommendation against dredging.** 

Given the very early ice-out this year, the dam was closed on March 13 (ice-out was March 8). With early ice-out dates more common, David and Owen will make recommendations if/how we should change and communicate spring dam closing dates for review at the annual meeting.
